
Area Overview Marylebone & Medical Territory Q4 2021 Lettings Report






Key Findings

- Rental values averaged £828 per week for flats and £1,430 per week for houses over the last 3 months.
- Properties let over the last 3 months achieved an average of £49.86 per square foot per annum in rent, up from £42.36 at the same time last year, and up from £46.46 6 months ago.
- The number of properties let over the last 3 months was down 63.0% versus the same period last year, but down 67.2% from 3 months ago.
- Achieved rental values rose by 17.7% compared to the same period last year, and rose by 7.3% versus 3 months ago.

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Key Findings

- 45.6% of properties have asking prices less than £1,000 per week, down from 50.0% from the previous 3 months and down from 75.8% from the same time last year.
- 16.2% of properties have asking prices of £2,000 or more per week.
- 18.8% of flats and 20.0% of houses currently available have seen a reduction in asking rents since they were first put on the market.
